Dr. Wolfe is an Emergency Medicine physician with a career spanning multiple disciplines, from Navy Seal and Air Force Pararescueman, to medical researcher and now EMS Director at a Level II Trauma Center, in addition to being a Law Enforcement SWAT Medical Director.

Dr. Wolfe is a 2015 graduate of Midwestern-AZCOM in Glendale, Arizona. He had substantial EMS and military experience prior to medical school, serving as an Air Force Pararescueman (PJ) with the Alaska Air National Guard for 11 years. In this role, he maintained parachute, dive, flight crew, and EMT-Paramedic certifications to conduct pre-hospital field medical care. He performed multiple combat search and rescue missions during deployments to Afghanistan and Kuwait.

In the first half of his military career, Dr. Wolfe served in the Navy as a SEAL. He traveled extensively supporting Naval Special Warfare objectives in over 20 countries on 3 continents. He served in five operational platoons, rising to the role of Leading Petty Officer of a Winter Warfare platoon.

“Given that Chinook is a medical supply and kitting company primarily focused on combat tactical medicine, I am excited to have another medical doctor, and fellow combat veteran, on our Advisory Board”, said Ben Crowder, CEO and owner of Chinook. “Steve not only brings his Emergency Medicine knowledge and experience to the team, but brings over 20 years of military experience as a former Marine, Navy Seal, and Air Force PJ.”

Dr. Wolfe has been active in research. As an awarded undergraduate research fellow for the Alaska Heart Institute, he collaborated with the Army Research Institute for Environmental Medicine as he investigated enhancing acclimatization at altitude. After this, he was awarded a grant to study endocrine hormones in mammals from the Idea Network for Biomedical Research Excellence. His most recent project on ultrasound fracture reduction was selected for poster presentation by the Society for Academic Emergency Medicine.
